

# **RMSA PEPSI CENTER BOOTH**

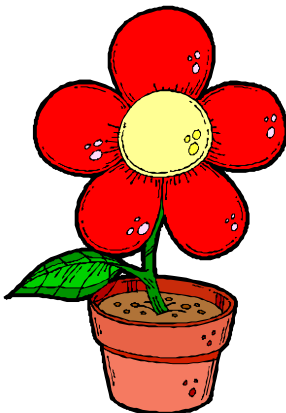
**(A great opportunity)**

Have you ever gone to a soccer game at the Colorado Rapids stadium, or the Rockies or Denver Broncos Game? If so, you have probably patronized some of the food stands at the stadium, or perhaps you have simply noticed the long lines at the concession stands. These stands are managed by a company called Aramark. They are charged with the responsibility to staff these stands. One of the ways they do it is through non-profit organizations such as the Rocky Mountain Soccer Academy. The stands are rented by different companies that sell various food items. One of those companies is Arbys which is run with RMSA volunteers.

It takes 6 people to run the stand for the various events (Hockey, Basketball, Lacrosse, Football, and Concerts). Lisa Russell is the RMSA Pepsi Center Volunteer Coordinator, and she is in-charge of staffing the Booth for the RMSA. Lisa Russell is an RMSA parent who volunteered to manage this important function for the Club. Needless to say, this is a big job and one that means a great deal to the RMSA and to the people who volunteer. The RMSA volunteers work on a commission basis, and the money is distributed equally amongst all volunteers. The RMSA receives 10% of the earnings which are used to fund several projects benefitting the RMSA members.

1. This is a very important fundraiser for the RMSA that allows us to keep our fees lower than any other club in our area, fund scholarships, and help purchase much needed equipment for the teams.
2. It is a source for revenue for families that need the money to help pay for soccer expenses. These expenses include fees, uniforms, soccer gear, tournament fees, hotel accommodations and expenses when traveling out of town for soccer related events.
3. The money you earn can be used for other sports, and for school activities including non-sports related activities such as band, etc.
4. The Pepsi Center also creates good will and visibility for the RMSA because our club volunteers are seen by many people who attend the Pepsi Center events.
5. Parents who do not need the money can donate their earnings to the RMSA Scholarship fund or directly to a beneficiary of their choice. This is a good and excellent way to do something to help others.
